

Virginia Pine

Botanical Name: *Pinus virginiana*

Pronunciation: PIE-nus ver-jin-ee-AY-nuh



Fun Facts:

- The Virginia Pine tree can grow up to 70 feet tall.
- Seed cones (or pine cones) take 2 years to mature, shedding seeds soon thereafter, and can stay on the tree for up to 5 years.
- The leaves are called needles, always come in pairs, are slightly twisted, and often turn yellow-green in winter.
- It is useful for reforestation and provides nourishment for wildlife.
- Its other main use is in Christmas tree plantations. It also can provide wood pulp and lumber.
- It is also known as Scrub Pine and Jersey Pine.
